How to get there?

By public transport

From Liszt Ferenc International Airport:

- by airport shuttle 100E to Astoria
- from Astoria by M2 metro line (red) to Keleti pályaudvar (Eastern Railway Station) (2 stops)
- from Keleti pályaudvar to Star City Hotel 10 minutes' walk on Nefelejts street.

From the main railway stations:

from Keleti pályaudvar (Eastern Railway Station)

• 10 minutes' walk on Nefelejts Street

from Déli Pályaudvar (Southern Railway Station)

- by M2 metro line (red) to Keleti pályaudvar (Eastern Railway Station) (7 stops)
- from Keleti pályaudvar to Star City Hotel 10 minutes' walk on Nefelejts street

from Nyugati Pályaudvar (Western Railway Station)

- by tram 4 or 6 to Blaha Lujza square (4 stops)
- from Blaha Lujza square by M2 metro line (red) to Keleti pályaudvar (1 stop)
- from Keleti pályaudvar to Star City Hotel 10 minutes' walk on Nefelejts street

Public Transport:

<u>Public Transport in Budapest</u> covers the city well by buses, trams, trolleybuses, metro and suburban railway trains. You can also travel with public bike-sharing service MOL Bubi, taxi or special transport services like the Funicular, Chairlift, or boat.

<u>Night transport services</u> are available in the night hours, they are different from the daytime operation. Trams run throughout the night on the Grand Boulevard, beyond that night buses are on service. Their numbers always start with 9, and their network covers the entire capital.

Tickets and passes can be purchased in cash or by bankcard from <u>ticket vending machines</u> (TVM) found at Budapest's busy transport hubs and stops.

You can also purchase your tickets and passes via **Budapest Go App**.

Taxi:

Taxis are painted in bright yellow. It is compulsory for them to use a taximeter that also gives a receipt. The price is calculated according to the distance travelled but also includes a fixed booking fee and a waiting fee (if appropriate). You can pay with a credit card and by cash. You can find them in front of all major hotels, train and bus stations, but it's better to call them via App. Reliable taxi companies are Főtaxi and Bolt taxi.

Currency:

Forint (HUF, Ft) is the currency in Hungary. There are coins of 5, 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 Forints. Banknotes have denominations of 500, 1.000, 2.000, 5.000, 10.000, 20.000 Forints. $1 \in 400$ Ft (approximately)
